Accessibility benefits everyone

At Shaker Lane School, **one in four** students requires additional support for learning disabilities, language learning, and behavioral issues. Shaker Lane's commitment to **Universal Design for Learning** drives the creation of inclusive and supportive educational environments, ensuring that lessons are designed to cater to a diverse range of student needs. **The goal: accessibility and engagement for all.**

The new Shaker Lane School supports Universal Design for Learning with:

Adaptable learning spaces that allow for collaboration, flexibility, intervention, and needs-based services—current space issues result in services at desks in busy hallways or in repurposed closets.

An accessible playground with rubber flooring makes for a safe and engaging experience for students of different abilities and interests—the current playground is not accessible and some equipment is broken.

A shared clinical suite for more collaboration between service providers, specialists and families, leading to better outcomes for students—current space issues mean repurposed offices are all over the building.

A YES vote for Shaker Lane is now *less expensive* for taxpayers than a NO vote.

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
